The Pentateuch (Torah)

- Genesis Creation, Fall, Election of Abraham,
 Covenant
- Exodus Children of Israel freed from Egyptian captivity, The Law
- Leviticus Ritual/Cultic Laws
- Numbers Years in the Wilderness, Apportionment of the Land (Levites assigned to the tabernacle and as priests and refuge cities throughout Canaan)
- Deuteronomy Preparation to possess Canaan, Covenant

Historical Books:

- Joshua Joshua leads Children of Israel into Canaan
- Judges Further conquests and residing in Canaan
- Ruth Story of loyalty and fidelity
- 1 Samuel Establishment of Kingship in Israel Saul and David Self-centered and God-centered
- 2 Samuel David becomes King, Civil War, Court Intrigue
- ▶ 1 Kings Solomon 1st Temple is built

Historical Books (cont'd):

Divided Kingdom after Solomon:

Jeroboam-Northern Kingdom (Israel) - 10 Tribes Rehoboam-Southern Kingdom (Judah) - 1 Tribe

- 2 Kings Kings of the Northern and Southern Kingdoms - good kings - mainly bad
- ▶ 1 Chronicles Genealogies of the Children of Israel, Conflicts with the Philistines, Saul and David's kingships, the preparation for the construction and administration of the Temple, the transfer of power from David to Solomon, and the death of David.

Historical Books (cont'd):

- 2 Chronicles Construction of the Temple, reign of Solomon, death of Solomon, the kingships of the divided kingdom, the Northern Kingdom (Israel) exiled to Assyria, the Southern Kingdom (Judah) exiled to Babylon, and the permission of King Cyrus to rebuild the Temple in Jerusalem.
- Ezra Return from Exile, rebuilding the Temple (Second Temple)
- Nehemiah Return from exile, rebuilding the Temple (Second Temple)
- Esther Female Savior of Israel

Wisdom Books:

- Job Suffering of the righteous, Justice of God, Where can Wisdom be found?
- Proverbs Rewards of Wisdom, Righteous vs. Wicked, Conduct.
- Ecclesiastes Life is transitory, Be careful what you value, Maintain reverence for God.

Poetic Books:

- Psalms 150 Psalms, Originally meant to be sung,
 5 Groupings meant to parallel Israel's history from King David to the repatriation of Palestine.
- Song of Solomon A love poem that talks about sexuality between a wife and a husband.
- ▶ Lamentations 5 Laments over the fall of Jerusalem

Prophetic Books: Major Prophets

- Isaiah God's sovereignty and majesty, God's love for Israel and his plans for judgment, redemption, and salvation.
- Jeremiah God's warnings and impending judgment against Judah and the nations.
- Ezekiel Prophecies about the fall of Jerusalem and the future restoration of Israel with the return of the Messiah
- Daniel Exaltation in captivity; prophetic visions about future kingdoms, and God's final judgment.
